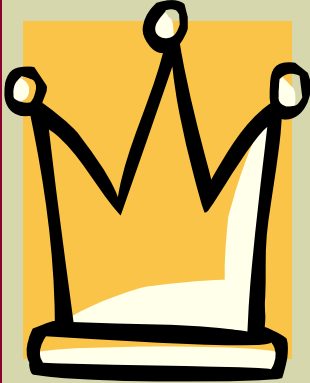

3. No recruits means less money raised for Camp Virginia Jaycee!

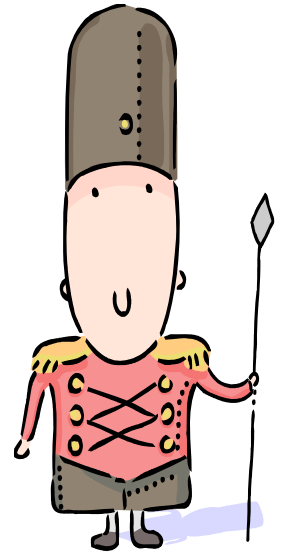

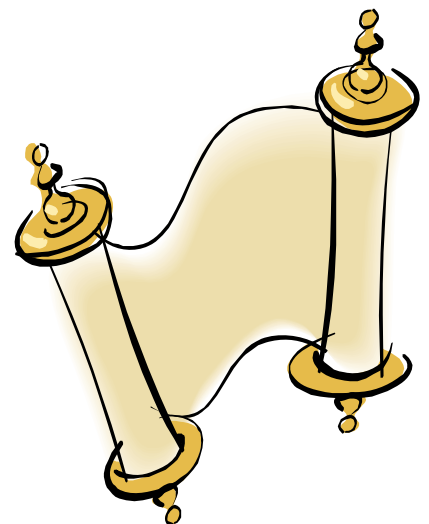
