Which SEX will win the battle.

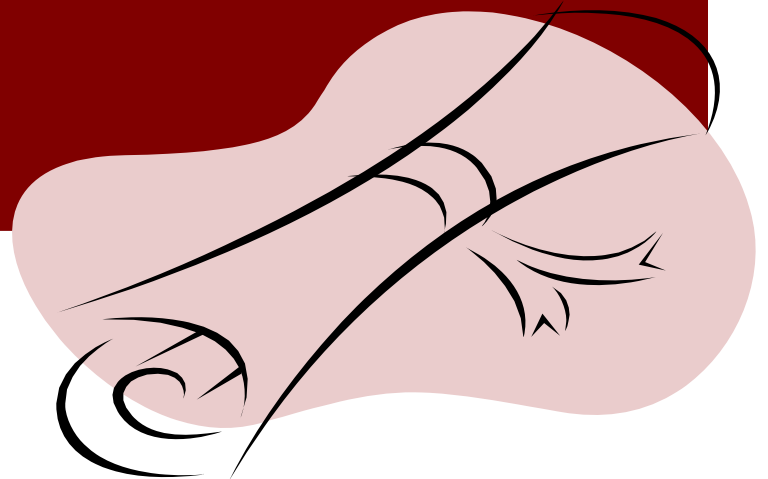
Which Colonel has a ROD fetish.

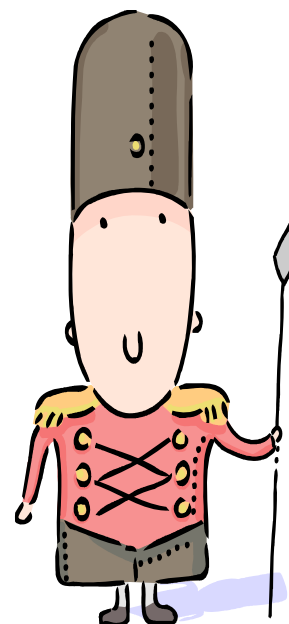
