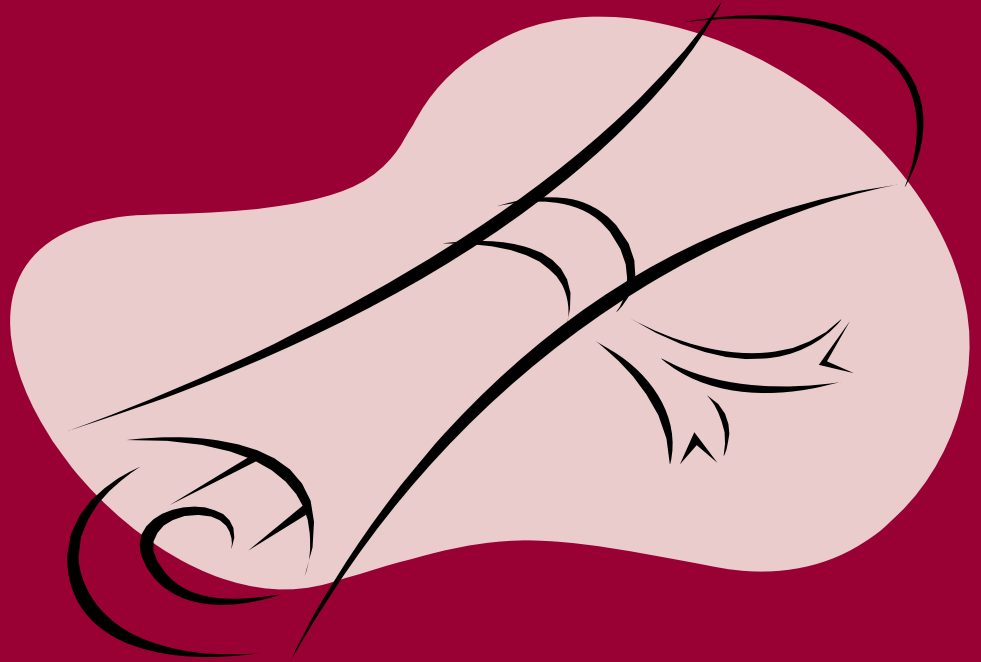

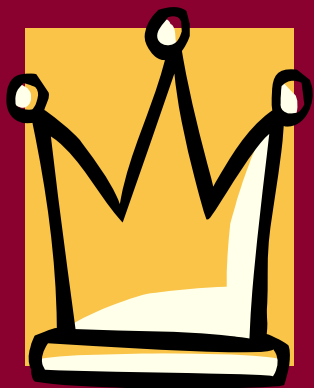

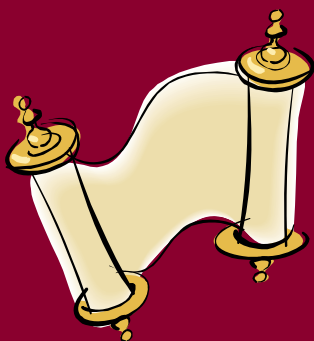


Who will reign Supreme in

To the Corps!

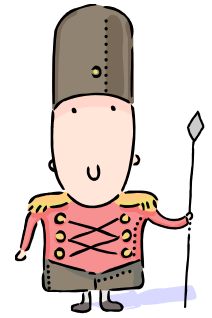

Minutes from August:
